"Then he opened their minds so they could understand the scriptures. He told them, "This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

Luke 24:45-49

I love to ride roller coasters and grew up visiting Six Flags in Atlanta often. I remember thinking as a teenager: "I wish there was a way you could just ride over and over without having to get back in line". I happened to be at Six Flags one weekend when a local radio station was offering a prize: Ride the "The Great American Scream Machine" longer than the other contestants and win a new car. The event started with 24 people. *Sixty-one days* later the 3 people who remained each won a new car after having ridden the roller coaster approximately *13,000 times*. I remember seeing the contestants, who were seated in the last car, and thinking how miserable they looked. It seemed to emphasize the point that too much of good thing is not that good for you.

The same cannot be said for the Easter season. Easter is such a powerful reminder of what Jesus accomplished on the cross that it would be a shame to simply treat it as one special day. Easter is not the end of our faith story – it is an invitation to join our Savior in accomplishing his plans for this world!

As believers we have the ability to understand the scriptures. This means we don't have to depend on our own wisdom to navigate this life, but that we have access to the mind of God in the decisions we have to make.

We are witnesses of the things Jesus did through God. Our story is better than any others because our Savior was dead and he came back to life! Now he has defeated sin and death, and in fact lives in us – what good news we have to offer the rest of the world!

We do not have to depend on our own strength, we have been promised power from on high. The Holy Spirit helps us to live out the life that God has created us for – thank goodness I don't have to do it on my own.

What a joy it is to experience the reverence of Holy Week this week with my church family, leading up to the celebration of Easter Sunday. Unlike the roller coasters of this world that we think we can't get enough of, the power of the Holy Spirit allows us to experience our faith in a way that never grows old or becomes monotonous. The message of Easter is not one day, or one week, but an ongoing testimony of who our Savior is – Jesus Christ Crucified and Risen!
