



A MOMENT FOR MISSIONS

Here at White Bluff UMC, we have always had two passions: education and children. Much of our mission work revolves around these passions. Collecting school supplies, donations of school uniforms and clothing, collecting children books, hand made dresses for the very poor, summer feeding program, backpack buddies, Sunday School for children, prayer meeting at the high school, community fairs, play dates, Christmas parties, Easter Egg Hunts and movies on the lawn just to name a few. We have members who faithfully go to schools to read to the children.

Because of our love of children and education, there are two new mission opportunities I would like to share with you. The first is a After-School Tutoring Program. White Bluff Presbyterian has had this program for years and it is making a difference. We met with WBPC and they shared with us the whole program, as well as an interest to work with us to help our neighbors in other ways. Second is a child evangelism program that puts the Bible and prayer back in public school. Yes, I said prayer and public school in the same sentence. It is an after school program held at the schools called "THE GOOD NEWS CLUB". It would meet weekly and students would learn about God, Jesus, and the Bible. Much like Sunday School at public school. This is perfectly legal and is already in place at Windsor Forest Elementary.
